We're Back in Uganda

As always, George and I are so grateful for your continued support and prayers. Your giving allows us to the hands and feet of our Lord and in tangible ways serve those that are serving here in Uganda and Sudan. We are blessed beyond measure by your gracious giving.

We had a safe and uneventful return trip to Uganda. We are now trying to get caught up. As much as we enjoyed our time with family and friends on furlough, we are excited to be back home in Uganda serving.

Since returning we have been preparing for teams that are scheduled to arrive in July. Two teams will be going together to FRM's compound in Nimule, Sudan. The teams will facilitate a Men's Conference, a Women's Conference and a VBS at CC Nimule and at Maranatha Chapel church plant in Pageri. Pageri is about an hour north of Nimule. They will also be having a clothing/backpack give away for the children in Pageri. Our time with them will be short but we have been assisting in the needs and preparation for the team and their ministry. Pray that the Lord will prepare the hearts of those that are going to hear the Word of God and for the team members who are coming to minister.

The Bible Training Program is going to start again in Nimule, Sudan in July as well. We look forward to hosting the pastors and teachers as they are transitioning to and from Sudan. Pray that the Holy Spirit will be upon the students that will be in training for about a year.

Pray that they will be diligent in their studies and that they will be able to receive all that will be shared with them from the Word.

I have finished my first semester of Biblical Greek with flying colors. We will begin again for our second semester in August. Please pray for me as the Lord has opened a door for me to do possible ministry at a local school. The schools in Uganda require Christian Education to be part of their program. The school currently allows one of my fellow bible college students, Dennis, to teach as much of the program as possible. During my initial visit with the school staff, they were open to us taking on as much of the program as possible and even a Women's Bible study with the teachers and staff. Dennis currently has a Friday Service at the school for the children. I will be meeting again with Dennis this next week to review the plans for this next period of school which begins in late May. Please pray that the Lord will lead and direct my participation in this ministry opportunity.

Finally, please pray for Bob and Suzanne Scott as they are with us through early June. They are from CC Ann Arbor, MI. They are on their vision tour to see if the guesthouse ministry is where the Lord is leading them to serve in the mission field. We are exposing them to everyday living, the culture and the guesthouse responsibilities and ministry.
